Scholarship Details 2010

STC India Chapter is pleased to announce the scholarship program for the year 2010. This scholarship sponsors the education of individuals who may, upon completion of the intended course of study, become contributors to the technical communication profession in India. This scholarship also encourages students to take up studies in technical writing and motivate Indian universities to start more courses in this field.

The chapter funds this scholarship to a maximum of Rs. 10,000 per individual.

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to motivate students who are pursuing degrees, diplomas, or certificate programs in technical communication at graduate or post-graduate levels within an established university. A technical communication degree, diploma, or certificate program is defined as a graduate or post-graduate program including, but not limited to, courses or papers such as Technical Writing, Technical Editing, Online Documentation, Desktop Publishing, or any other course that will enable students to pursue their technical communication career.

Eligibility

Applicants who are enrolled or planning to enroll in a graduate degree, post-graduate degree, diploma, or certificate course run by a college or university in India that offers any of the following options:

- A full-time, one-year post-graduate diploma with at least one dedicated paper on technical communication.
- A full-time, two-year post-graduate degree with at least one dedicated paper on technical communication.
- A short-term certificate course dedicated to technical communication. Short-term is defined as less than one year. Participants enrolled in both full-time and part-time certificate courses are eligible to apply.

Amount and Number

The STC India chapter offers four scholarships for the year 2010. They are as follows:

- Two scholarships of Rs. 10,000 each for degree or diploma students.
- Two scholarships of Rs. 4,000 each for students in short-term certificate courses.

The upper limit on each type of scholarship is Rs 10,000 and Rs 4,000 each respectively.

Proof of Fees Paid

To receive the scholarship amount, students undertaking a degree or a diploma course, selected for Rs 10,000 scholarship, have to pay the fee to the university or college, and then send a copy of the receipt to the STC India chapter.

Certificate course students, pre-selected for the Rs. 4,000 scholarship, have to send the fee receipt and a copy of the report card to the STC India Chapter Scholarship Manager.

Important Dates

Application forms and additional information must be received by August 10, 2010.

Selected candidates will be informed by August 30, 2010.

Persons Not Eligible

Members of the STC India Chapter Admin Council and their family members are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.
